he is bona fide upon - 160
acres of vacant public land, situated
in said County - and surveyed for -
him on the 7th day of August
A.D. 1872 by D. A. Carter Deputy Surveyor
of said County, that he occupied and
improved the same as a homestead for
the period of three consecutive years -
Beginning on the 10th day of January 1871
that he is the head of a family -
and that he makes this affidavit for
the purpose of obtaining a title to the
same for a homestead under an act
supplementary to an act to regulate
the disposal of the public lands of the
State of Texas" approved March 24th 1871 -
and that he has not a homestead
other than the above and also at the
same time came and personally appeared.
